As well as the above, there can be other reasons why a warmer home is needed.	
xii. A member of the household is aged 60 or over	
xiii. There is a child under the age of 5	
xiv. A member of the household is pregnant	
Note. Whilst we do not require any medical certificates to support the above conditions the surveyor visiting the property may ask for some evidence such as medication, and it could also be required during any subsequent audit that may be carried out.
